GENERAL:

- 1) **THESE RULES WERE VOTED ON BY THE KCCSC BODY!!!**
 - a) **They apply to everyone with a membership and their guests.**
 - b) **It is the Members responsibility to obtain and abide by these rules!!**
 - c) **IGNORANCE OF THE RULES does not exempt you from the rules or disciplinary actions!!!**

- 2) Memberships:
 - a) A regular membership shall include husband, wife and children under 21 years of age residing at home and in school and grandchildren under the age of 18.
 - b) Two adults sharing the same household may acquire a membership with board approval.
 - c) If you become a member after October 1st, your membership will carry over to the next year however you must fill out a new application for the next year.
 - d) The KCCSC Board may terminate the membership of any member of KCCSC, any guest(s) or any person under the control of said member from any activity that threatens the safety or the right to a peaceful enjoyment of their KCCSC membership.

- 3) Anyone 18 years of age or older is entitled to two (2) consecutive day visits per year in which they may participate in KCCSC activities, (camping, fishing, swimming, ATV, s range and holiday activities), after this they are required to purchase a membership.
 - a) This does not apply to a guest visiting a member's camper and not participating in KCCSC activities.
 - b) Visitors MUST be with a member.

- 4) Memberships joining after October 1st cannot vote for that year.
 - a) Any applicant being denied can apply again in one year.

- 5) All outstanding debt to KCCSC must be paid in full by October 1st to attend the annual election and rules meeting.
- 6) Memberships and all fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- 7) Winter camping from November 1st through March 31st with board approval only and with a letter of intent turned into a board member.
- 8) If you attend a work weekend (8hrs) you will receive a \$50.00 voucher to apply to the following years social membership (one voucher per membership). If unable to complete hours on a work weekend you must make arrangements with the board.
- 9) The KCCSC will not assume responsibilities for any personal injury at any time.
- 10) The KCCSC is **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for accidents, injuries and/or property damage or loss of property.
- 11) Mushroom hunting is allowed on KCCSC property by **MEMBERS ONLY** and with a mesh bag. No GUESTS ARE ALLOWED TO MUSHROOM HUNT.
- 12) Any malicious or intentional damage done to KCCSC property must be paid for by those causing the damage. Failure to pay the damages may result in loss of membership and prosecution for vandalism.
- 13) No unnecessary noise between the hours of 12:00 am and 7:00 am.
 - a) Special events will be left to the discretion of the majority of the KCCSC Board members present.
 - b) A parent must accompany anyone under 16 years of age after 12:00 am. (midnight)
- 14) All trash must be taken to the dumpster. No electronics or large items, dumping of these and other items may result in a written violation.
- 15) Membership is required, unless board approval is given, to use the dump station.
- 16) Members **MUST** use the proper sanitary hose and airtight container when using the dump station. The violation of this rule will be a 30-day suspension, 2nd VIOLATION WILL BE TERMINATION.
 - a) Members **MUST** clean up the area before leaving the dump station.
- 17) From NOVEMBER 1ST TO APRIL 1ST the front gate will be locked or at boards discretion.

- a) Power and water to shelters will be shut off.
 - b) Water will be turned back on in April, weather permitting.
 - c) Combination to gate lock is: 2020
- 18) **ABSOLUTLEY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED PAST THE HUNTERS MAILBOX OR IN THE FRONT WOODS AND TRAILS!**
- 19) **ONLY STATE OF ILLINOIS APPROVED FIREWORKS** are allowed on KCCSC property.
- 20) Any children under 17 years old participating in adult activities must be accompanied by parent or have written consent from parent, EXCLUDING HUNTING.
- 21) All activities must be brought to a board meeting prior to event and approved by KCCSC Board.
- a) No “last minute” activities which could jeopardize the safety of members or interfere with Activities Committee events.
 - b) Anyone can speak with the Activity Committee to schedule events.
- 22) Board meetings are held on the 2nd Saturday of each month, unless otherwise posted.
- 23) “Conceal and Carry” will not be allowed on the grounds of KCCSC. All guns must be transported through the campground with either a trigger lock or in a locked hard case or an action lock. Absolutely no exceptions will be tolerated.
- a) It is the members responsibility to advise their guest(s) of our Conceal and Carry rule.
- 24) THE SPEED LIMITS on grounds of KCCSC are posted and WILL BE ENFORCED!!!
- 25) All motorized vehicles are to obey the posted speed limits on all the roads in the campground, ball diamond or any grassy area on grounds.

TENT CAMPING AND TEMPORARY CAMPER SPOTS:

- 26) Regular memberships are entitled to tent camp at no charge.
- a) A regular membership with a camper shall pay \$20.00 for everyday Camper is in rental area.
 - b) Tents using electricity shall pay \$5. 00 per day.
 - c) Non-members shall pay \$10.00 per night for any vehicle without camping facilities and \$25.00 per night with camping facilities. THE kCCSC Board has the discretion to classify vehicles.
 - d) Overnight campers are responsible to pay fees in advance to the treasurer or a board member.
 - e) Tents must be m oved every 5 days.
 - f) Truck type campers must remain on truck.
 - g) Any off the road camper that has not paid a camping fee must pay a dumping fee of \$20.00.
 - h) Up to board discretion.

PETS:

- 27) NO dogs, cats or pet animals will be allowed on the grounds to the detriment of other members.
- a) Pets must always be on a leash while in the campground and a person must be in control of the leash.

- b) Should such animal(s) become dangerous or a nuisance, member will remove it on order of two (2) board members.
- c) Clean up after your pet's waste.
- d) Temporary pet control areas are allowed if they are in good condition and at the discretion of the KCCSC Board.

PERMANENT CAMPSITES:

- 28) No loaning of campers to friends who have joined as a regular member.
 - a) Children/Parents/Grandparents/Grandchildren of a camping member who is 18 years and older and have their own membership may use their Parents/Children/Grandparents/Grandchildren's camper without the Parents/Children/Grandparents/Grandchildren being present.
 - b) Sibling member use with board approval.
- 29) A parent or a responsible adult member must accompany minors under 18 who are camping overnight. This will be enforced!!
- 30) A permanent camper spot will be given to a paid member in order of the waiting lists. Turn in written requests to be put on waiting list.
 - a) You are entitled to your spot for one (1) year from the date on your receipt of payment from said spot unless your camper is pulled out and/or no name is displayed.
 - b) All campers must notify Spoon River Electric Co-Op to have their meter activated. You must activate your meter within 30 days of getting your Lot and remain active with proof of current status (active) upon KCCSC Boards request during the camping season, which is APRIL 1ST-OCTOBER 1ST each year.

- c) Lot size will be determined by a distance equal to 1/2 the distance between service poles, 25" front to back of poles.
 - d) May have two (2) tents temporarily on Lots with a camper, but they must be moved every 5 days. Any more than two (2) must have board approval.
- 31) Illinois state Law requires that all camper hook-up cords be #12-3 wire or larger. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.
- a) There is to be no burying of power cords or water supply lines and no power cords attached to trees.
- 32) There will be direct hook-ups for water with one (1) access to be left open.
- a) Each water source must have a vacuum breaker at the source. THIS IS AN ILLINOIS STATE LAW!!! If you remove your vacuum breaker for any reason and that action causes the KCCSC any costs or fines, YOU will be responsible to pay any costs or fines accessed!!!
- 33) No campers on the North side of the KCCSC Lake without Board approval.
- 34) No burning barrels are allowed.
- a) Trashcans with lids are permitted at campsites.
- 35) Refrigerators will not be allowed outside campers.
- 36) All weeds and grass growing at campsites will be the responsibility of the member to be trimmed every 2 weeks or when it has reached a maximum of 8" high.
- a) A \$50.00 assessment will be charged to you if your grass and weeds grow (maximum 8") and grounds committee have to mow them.
- 37) ALL CAMPERS MUST BE SELF- CONTAINED!!
- a) No waste or gray water is to be run on the ground.

- b) Airtight containers must be used, and discharge hose hooked to camper MUST also be hooked to an airtight container. At all times.
 - c) THESE ARE ILLINOIS STATE REGULATIONS!!!
 - d) Digging a hole to lower your tank may be allowed, but only with KCCSC board approval.
- 38) Any camp spot switching must be approved at a KCCSC Board meeting. Persons must be present.
- 39) The selling of any camper staying on KCCSC property must be board approved and the Buyer and Seller must be present at meeting prior to transaction.
- 40) Decks may be put at the entrance of your camper if they are free standing and made of treated wood.
- a) Notify a board member before starting to build your deck.
 - b) Decks may be no longer than your camper and no wider than 10 ft, unless otherwise approved by the KCCSC Board.
 - c) Other materials may be used with prior board approval.
 - d) Any overhead structure must be board approved.
- 41) Only one (1) camper is allowed per Lot.
- 42) All sheds must be KCCSC Board approved before putting up.

FIRES AND WOOD CUTTING:

- 43) Wood cutting is for members and campground use only!!!
- a) All brush from woodcutting must be piled.
 - b) NO LIVE TREES MAY BE CUT without board approval.
 - c) Committee chair may decide on tree cutting on workdays.
 - d) Tree trimming is acceptable if it poses a threat or damage to your camper with board approval.
 - e) Wood piles must be 6 inches off ground. May use wood pallets.
- 44) No fires except in designated areas and in proper containers or fire ring.

- a) If in doubt, ask a KSSCS Board member.
- b) NO UNATTENDED FIRES are allowed after the water has been shut off in the fall. Campers must have their own way to extinguish fire.

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS:

- 45) The use of illegal drugs, narcotics, marijuana or any controlled substance is prohibited on KCCSC property.
 - a) Medical necessity by prescription must be used in private.
 - b) This is an AUTOMATIC TERMINATION!!!

- 46) Consumption and transportation of alcoholic beverages is allowed in Camping areas and fishing areas, unless designated differently by the KCCSC Board to allow for approved activities.
 - a) All alcoholic beverages and containers MUST BE TRANSPORTED in an ENCLOSED container while on KCCSC property. Cooler cups are not considered acceptable containers.

- 47) Absolutely NO BEER KEGS allowed anywhere on KCCSC grounds.
 - a) This is an AUTOMATIC TERMINATION of membership!!!

- 48) ABSOLUTLEY NO OPEN ALCOHOL WHILE OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE on the grounds of KCCSC.

ATVS, UTVS AND GOLF CARTS AND BICYCLES:

- 49) RIDING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES OR PARTICIPATING IN ACTIVITIES ON KCCSC PROPERTY IS **"AT YOUR OWN RISK"**.
- 50) Children under 16 years old may ride on the roads if they are safe and obey the rules.
- 51) Individual riding privileges are at the ATV committees and Boards discretion.
- 52) Riding on any motorized, unlicensed off-road vehicles will stop at 12:00 am (midnight).
- 53) GUESTS MAY OPERATE motorized, unlicensed, tested and insured off-road vehicles. Guests **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER!!!**
- 54) Evening or night riding of bicycles or motorized vehicles requires that lights be on!!!
- 55) Golf carts and bicycles are not allowed on off-road trails.
 - a) Golf carts must be driven responsibly and **MUST** have operating lights.
- 56) GOLF CARTS and UTV'S will not have more than two (2) PASSENGERS on them at a time if the driver is **LESS THAN 16 YEARS OLD** unless an adult is onboard.
- 57) All 4 WHEELERS may have only one (1) passenger if driver is **LESS THAN 16 YEARS OLD** unless an adult is onboard.
- 58) Majority of KCCSC Board has the discretion to classify vehicles.
- 59) Any off-road vehicles used on KCCSC property must be insured and tested by the ATV committee.
- 60) KCCSC Board may request proof of insurance at any time!!!
- 61) No riding of vehicles through campsites: only on roads and off-road trails.
- 62) Only 4-Wheelers, golf carts and UTV'S are allowed on KCCSC grounds for recreational purposes.
- 63) If you cannot abide by these rules, you may not start your vehicle until you reach the road.

- 64) Absolutely NO washing of motorized vehicles allowed except in authorized areas.
- 65) An adult must accompany persons under age 16 on all motorized vehicles to North side of Lake.
- 66) The ATV committee or a board member will check any motorized vehicle that is too loud.
 - a) If a problem is found, the vehicle will need to be fixed before being allowed to ride again at KCCSC.
 - b) Recreational motorized vehicles will be tested annually for exhaust decibels, not to exceed 96 decibels.
 - c) Decibel tests must be done by opening weekend to be allowed to ride. Testing fee is \$5.00. After opening weekend, it is a \$10.00 unless it is a new vehicle or new member.
- 67) Anyone 15 YEARS AND UNDER must wear a DOT APPROVED HELMET to ride 4-Wheelers. Also, must have a helmet on UTV'S in timber and kids track.
 - a) Proper shoes are also required. NO OPEN TOED SHOES!!!
 - b) NO BICYCLE HELMETS are allowed while riding recreational motorized vehicles.
 - c) HELMETS are required at signage.
- 68) UTV- Children under the age of 16 MUST wear a seatbelt if equipped while in the campground including the timber and kids track.
- 69) NO BURNOUTS ALLOWED IN THE GRASSY AREA OR ON THE ROADS!!
- 70) No riding around the shelter during activities.

LAKE, FISHING AND BEACH:

- 71) Swimming hours are from 9 am to dusk.
 - a) NO ONE MAY SWIM ALONE: THIS IS A STATE LAW!!!

- b) A parent or responsible adult member MUST ACCOMPANY all children UNDER 17 in the swimming area.
 - c) No profanity, rowdiness, nude swimming or nude sunbathing will be allowed on beach or anywhere else on KCCSC property.
 - d) NO ALCOHOL in the water and NO GLASS CONTAINERS on the beach or in the water.
 - e) NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE BEACH OR SWIMMING AREA.
 - f) NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED ON THE BEACH, except to drag the beach.
 - g) SWIMMING ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.
- 72) Pole and Line fishing only.
- a) A limit of 2 fishing poles allowed per person and may not be left unattended at any time.
 - b) Children may fish alone with a parent's permission: CHILDREN UNDER AGE 12 MUST WEAR A LIFE JACKET!!!
 - c) No fishing allowed within 20 feet of swimming ropes.
 - d) Only minnows obtained from our lake are permitted to be used as bait.
 - e) Possession Limits for our Lake are: 5 CATFISH, 5 BASS (except bass measuring 13-15 inches, these are breeders, please release them) and 10 CRAPPIES PER CALENDER DAY OR 10 CATFISH, 10 BASS AND 20 CRAPPIES PER CALENDER WEEK. These limits are PER MEMBERSHIP.
 - f) You may keep as many other types of fish as you may catch.
 - g) There are NO TROT LINES, THROW LINES, JUG LINES OR TRAPS allowed in the KCCSC Lake.
 - h) NO GUEST SHALL FISH WITHOUT A MEMBER PRESENT!!!
 - i) Any person fishing must possess a valid fishing license.
- 73) Only trolling motors are allowed on boats in the lake, not gas, unless board approved.
- 74) KCCSC will not be responsible for boats.

- 75) All boats must be labeled with owner's name and tied with chain or cable to tree, turned upside down and removed from lake area from November 1st to April 1st.

TRAILS:

- 76) NO one under 16 years old on unapproved trails without parent, legal guardian or responsible adult over 18 years of age.
- 77) No one under 12 years old allowed in timber on ATV/UTV after sunset.
- 78) Golf carts and bicycles are not allowed on off-road trails.

DUES/FEES AND FAILURE TO PAY DUES AND FEES:

- 79) If campers fail to pay their dues or do not pick up their property within 30 days, they will be charged a storage/late fee of \$100.00 per month and will lose their camping spot.
- a) This will cause the KCCSC to consider to property abandoned.
 - b) KCCSC has the right to move offending trailers not picked up or paid for.
 - c) If any legal action is necessary, either to evict a trailer or collect storage fees, the member shall pay the legal fees and costs associated with the collection and eviction of said trailer.
 - d) The individual member who places a camper on the rounds and/or pays member dues and fees are expressly agreeing to the provisions of the contract.
 - e) Once you have left your camper abandoned and failed to pay your membership dues and fees you are TRESSPASSING!!! Therefore, KCCSC CAN DENY YOU THE RIGHT TO COME BACK ONTO THE PROPERTY.

- 80) Anyone who is in arrears of \$100.00 or in arrears for 45 days or more may lose their membership.
- 81) Regular memberships dues (\$130.00 per calendar year) and Hunting fees are due starting Jan 1st of each membership year and due NO LATER than March 1st.
- a) \$10.00 of membership dues will go toward fish fund and \$10.00 will go to Lake fund.
- 82) Permanent camping fees are \$400.00 per year in addition to the regular membership dues of \$130.00. A minimum of \$200.00 (one half of total camp fees) is required at the time you get your camp spot. The remainder of total camp fees is due within 60 days of first payment.
CAMP FEES ARE DUE ON THE FIRST DAY OF YOUR ANNIVERSARY MONTH AND MUST BE MAILED/RECEIVED BY THE BOARD MEETING OF YOUR ANNIVERSARY MONTH TO AVOID A \$100.00 LATE FEE This is not to be confused with the January 1st due date for regular memberships of \$130.00.
- 83) Hunting fees are \$25.00 per person age 18 and over, in addition to the regular membership dues!!! *A hunting member's children/grandchildren, 17 years and younger with proper state required licenses and permits may hunt with any adult hunting member, but always MUST be under the supervision of an adult hunting member while on KCCSC property.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- 84) Persons under the same membership cannot serve on the KCCSC Board at the same time unless no other interested candidate can be found.
- 85) In order to serve on the Board, you must have already been a member for at least 2 years (24 consecutive months by September 1st)
- 86) Any decisions made by e-mail or text by The Board of Directors is to be brought to the following months agenda.

- 87) No person can serve on the KCCSC Board for more than 4 consecutive years unless the Board is unable to fill the seat otherwise.

VIOLATIONS AND COMPLAINTS:

- 88) Complaints by a member **MUST** be in writing and signed by person(s) filing complaint and any witnesses if possible.
- a) Bring written complaint to any board member.
 - b) Person(s) filing complaint must appear at next Board meeting.
 - c) You have from date of offense until the beginning of the next board meeting to file a complaint.
 - d) NO VERBAL complaints will be accepted outside of board meetings.
 - e) If the issue is addressed and the complainant has said no write up is necessary or all parties are in agreement that the issue has been resolved then a write up for the same issue shall not be accepted at a later date.
- 89) Violations of KCCSC rules will be disciplined as follows UNLESS AUTOMATIC TERMINATION applies at the Board's discretion:
- a) 1st Violation = Written Warning
 - b) 2nd Violation = 30-day suspension
 - c) 3rd Violation = TERMINATION from KCCSC
 - d) Unless otherwise noted with a rule.
 - e) Any member under a violation will not be able to run for the Board/ after second violation a member will not be allowed to vote.
 - f) Any discipline will fall off after 12 months from date of occurrence.

RANGE:

- 90) ABSOLUTELY NO HIGH-POWERED RIFLES are allowed anywhere on KCCSC property, except 22 rifles are allowed for range use only.

- 91) All firearms must always conform to the range rules and places while on KCCSC property.

CLUB RANGE RULES:

- a) ONLY ALL STATE LEGAL handguns, shotguns, blackpowder and .22 cal. rim fire or smaller. HANDGUNS AND .22 RIMFIRE or SMALLER is for Range use ONLY!!!! (NO HUNTING)
- b) Sundays after 2 pm-Thursday dusk (EXCEPT HOLIDAYS) may shoot anytime during daylight hours. Friday through Sunday 2pm and Holidays you must schedule shooting times with the KCCSC Board at a Board meeting.
- c) Range is closed October 1st thru January 1st.
- d) Shooters are responsible for putting up and taking down flags and chains at the road, pines and two (2) trail openings. Signs are in the mailbox on the pole.
- e) ALL STATE LAWS APPLY!! While transporting firearms on KCCSC property, all firearms will be locked, all firearms will be trigger locked or locked in a hard case or an action lock. AMMO will be stored in a SEPARATE LOCKED CASE or put in a secured area (ex: Locked vehicle or camper).
- f) For all range activity, NO TRANSPORTATION OF WEAPONS on ATV'S, UTV'S or GOLF CARTS!!!
- g) All shooting must be done in the berm except for shotguns using birdshot.
- h) In accordance with Illinois State Laws, No one under 18 may shoot a shotgun and no one under 21 may shoot a handgun without an adult present.
- i) Any violation of the range rules and Rule #89 and #90 will be up to the discretion of the KCCSC Board for disciplinary actions. **NO 3 STRIKES!!!!**
- j) **Range users must sign in and out and leave phone number for persons to contact to enter range if needed.**
- k) Rules may only be changed by a majority of the Board of Directors.

- l) Chains and Flags are to be put up for Archery and Crossbow practice.

SHOOTING RANGE RULES:

- a) No one under the influence of drugs or alcohol may use the range.
- b) Hearing and Eye protection recommended.
- c) Treat every weapon as if it is loaded.
- d) Trigger finger shall remain outside the trigger guard until ready to fire.
- e) Firearms shall always be pointed down range, weapon on safe and the action will be open. Handguns may be holstered.
- f) Never move down range until the firing line is clear.
- g) All firing must stop for persons to leave and enter the range.
- h) Pick up all brass and trash when done using the range, store tables under the pavilion.

HUNTING RULES:

- 92) Muzzle loader, Bow and arrow and shotgun hunting ONLY!!!
- 93) Handguns may be used for Deer season ONLY!!!
- 94) NO HUNTING is allowed in the CAMPGROUND of KCCSC.
 - a) Hunting is allowed anywhere beyond the barbed wire area at the south side of the kids track and at the west side of the Pine trees adjoining the 3-D area.
 - b) STAND OR BLIND HUNTING ONLY during deer season.
 - c) Bow hunting is allowed in front of timber 100 yards from campers.
- 95) NO ADMITTANCE BEYOND THE FLAG AND CHAIN during hunting season when flag is displayed.

- a) NO RIDING of any motorized vehicles from October 1st to January 1st in the hunting area or 3-D trails or front of timber, or past the mailboxes except to retrieve game or special vehicle parking set by the Hunting Committee.
- b) Hunters MUST sign the register sheet and MUST DISPLAY THE RED FLAG AND CHAIN!!!!
- c) No permanent stands are allowed in designated hunting areas.
- d) One stand per hunter.
- e) Stands are to be put up no sooner Monday (Labor Day) before hunting season and taken down no later than two (2) weeks after hunting season.
- f) No stands or blinds are to be put up after October 1st (up to the discretion of the Hunting Committee).
- g) All hunters must attend a safety meeting and sign in to state that are going to hunt.

HUNTING RULES: Approved by Board only

IT IS MANDATORY THAT YOU MUST ATTEND ONE (1) OF THE HUNTING MEETINGS EACH AND EVERY YEAR IN ORDER TO HUNT.

STANDS WILL BE PICKED AT THE AUGUST MEETING

- 1) You must sign in at the mailbox. When you sign in you need to have the date, your name and the time in. When you leave, you need to put the time out and any game taken.
- 2) Make sure that two (2) ENTRY CHAINS ARE UP.
- 3) After January 1st, you must take signs down and put up only when hunting.
- 4) Hunt only in designated hunting areas.
- 5) Stands and blinds can be put up starting (MONDAY) Labor Day.

- 6) Per the club rules, no stands can be put in after October 1st. Stands and ground blinds can be no farther than 15 yards apart.
- 7) Stands and blinds must be taken down two (2) weeks after deer season, weather permitting.
- 8) No stalking or Deer drives. Hunting only from stands and blinds.
- 9) No bows should have been knocked before arriving at stand.
- 10) You can use ATV'S to retrieve your game. **HUNTERS** may ride ATV'S/UTV'S to their stands with the following stipulations:
 - a) Must be at stand 10 minutes prior to legal shoot time.
 - b) No riding out before 9 am unless emergency.
 - c) May ride between 1 pm-3 pm.
 - d) All weapons must be cased and locked while transported. ANY VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN YOU WALKING FOR THE REST OF THE SEASON!
- 11) You must follow all Illinois Hunting Rules and Regulations.
- 12) You can hunt in your immediate family members stand only. You must note whose stand you are in when signing in if you are not in your stand.
- 13) Game retrieval after 9 am depending on the weather. Be courteous to other hunters.
- 14) If no one is signed in by 8:00 am, you are allowed to hunt small game and be out by noon. If no one is signed in by 3:30 pm, you are allowed to hunt small game until dark. Only deer hunting during firearm season.
- 15) Stands can no longer be moved.
- 16) One membership can only take 4 Deer per season.
- 17) A hunter must get committee approval to move stand from previous year's spot.

**REMEMBER SAFETY IS FIRST, RESPECT ALL OTHER HUNTERS
AND HAVE FUN.**
